Tarp Flip (Turn Over a New Leaf)

After attendance tell the students to <u>"Clear out the Middle"</u> The students will move the desks to the sides of the room. Just sit back and watch them go. This should be done rather quickly. (Class 1 <u>"Clears out the Middle"</u> and Class 2 students will put the desks back the way they're supposed to be at the end of the day). They should now "Circle Up."

While standing on top of a completely open tarp, the group must create a plan to get everyone on the opposite side of the tarp without anyone stepping off. This activity requires problem solving skills, communication and effective team involvement.

None of the classes have accomplished this goal.

The tarp is in the cupboard near cupboard #6 or under the table.

Sometimes I put limitations on the assignment just to make it more entertaining.
