

sculpted directly from the rock face



# Hathor Temple



To the north of the main temple is a smaller temple that was built in honor of Ramses' great wife, Nefertari, and the goddess Hathor.

At the solstices, twice a year (February 21 and October 21) the dawn sunlight is aligned to light the entire length of the temple, lighting up three of the four statues.



- world's largest man-made lake, Lake Nasser.





If the Egyptians built the new dam, it meant that the temples would be flooded.







## The Two Ton Jigsaw Puzzle

The reconstructed temples were moved 64 m higher up the valley, and refigured along the outside and the inside of a concrete dome.






### Concrete Dome



The reconstruction of both temples was so accurate, that no one can see from the outside that the hill is hollow and actually a concrete dome.
