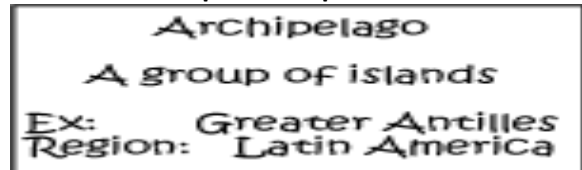


16 Squares

Example of a Square



Step 1 Complete the "Regions of the World" Worksheet.

Note: **Latin America** is where the people most commonly speak Spanish.
Spanish is derived from another language called Latin.

Step 2 Use your textbook, map, globe, encyclopedia, atlas or other reference materials to find the 16 features that are numbered ⑧ and in bold on the Geo Terms Map page.

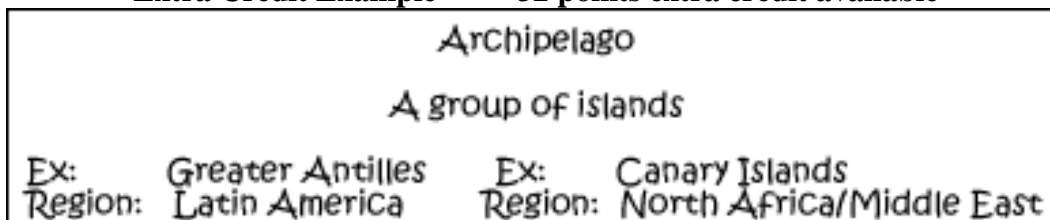
1. Fold a new piece of paper so that there are 8 boxes.
