

“I have ... Who has...?” Puzzle

Puzzle pieces are in the white bag in drawer #3.

CW ~ How to PLAY the game ~ Do not tape the pieces together.

The object of the game is for you to put all of the pieces in one long chain of pieces. Play the game on the floor.

The “I have....” is the answer to the question on the previous piece.

I have China.

Who has a country whose capital is Oslo?

I have Norway.

**Who has the country that borders
the Transylvanian Alps?**

I have Romania.

**Who has the country that borders
Denmark?**

Sometimes you will need to move pieces and exchange pieces within your 42 piece set in order to get them into one long line. It does not matter which piece you start with because the last piece’s answer will loop back to the very first piece at the top. If it doesn't loop or you get two lines then you might have a wrong answer or a piece in the wrong spot.

Trip Students or Prearrange Absent Students - If this assignment is for a student who is on an absence then solve the puzzle that was given to you and then tape the pieces together.
