- Where is the best place for a signal fire?
- What will be the source of your materials for shelter?
- Where will your source of fresh water be?
- What will be your source of fuel? Where will you get it?
- Where is the best place to grow crops? Why is the region you selected a good place?
- Who should be the leader of the settlement the Captain of the ship, the leader of the settlers or someone elected?
- How will conflicts likely be settled? Will there be laws? If yes, give two examples of laws you would want.
